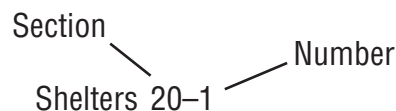

**How to Choose a Shelter, Sanctuary or Rescue:**

**SANCTUARIES** provide a permanent haven for lost, found, stray, homeless, surrendered, abused or abandoned animals. Sanctuaries

may have facilities specifically designed to provide care for animals and strive to ensure each animal is provided with good long term care that includes comfortable socialization with humans and other animals, exercise, spay/neuter and veterinary care.

**RESCUES** provide a temporary haven for lost, found, stray, homeless, surrendered, abused or abandoned animals. Rescues usually house a few animals at a time in a private setting, such as a home, and strive to re-home animals through an adoption process that should include spay/neuter. Some Rescuers also breed animals.

**SHELTERS** provide a haven for lost, found, stray, homeless, surrendered, abused or abandoned animals. Shelters usually have facilities specifically designed to provide care for animals and strive to re-home animals through an adoption process that should include spay/neuter.

**OPEN-ADMISSION SHELTERS** must accept every animal. Open-admission shelters may humanely euthanize animals who fail temperament tests and are dangerous to humans or other animals, are ill, diseased or suffering and those who are unclaimed or not adopted.

**LIMITED-ADMISSION SHELTERS** can accept very few animals because they choose not to euthanize and must set a limit on the number of animals they take in. Failing to set and adhere to a limit is an indicator of animal hoarding.

Good limited-admission shelters:

- have a policy to euthanize suffering or dangerous animals as well as those who develop aggression or psychological distress during prolonged confinement;

#### Choosing a Shelter, Cont'd:

- have the space, time and resources to provide adequate care to each animal;
- know the number of animals they can provide long-term care for;
- spay and neuter every animal they care for;
- know they can supplement an open-admission animal shelter, but cannot substitute for one;
- don't use the term "no-kill" or raise funds to the detriment of open-admission shelters.

Every limited-admission shelter must: euthanize some animals; cause the abandonment or continued abuse of animals they cannot accept; and rely on open-admission shelters who must euthanize in order to provide care for all animals.

Whether you are an individual, rescue group or shelter, when you're looking to place an animal in a shelter or rescue the following steps will help ensure you're doing the best you can for the animals:

- Visit the shelter, sanctuary or rescue – ask for a tour of all the buildings.
- Observe the other animals. Are they clean and happy or dirty, shy and starved for attention?
- Ask: how the animal will be cared for?;
- how many animals the shelter can care for?;
- about the euthanasia policy for suffering animals;;
- about adoption and spay/neuter policies; if the animal will stay at that facility or be adopted or sold;
- if the shelter, sanctuary or rescue will receive income from the animal.

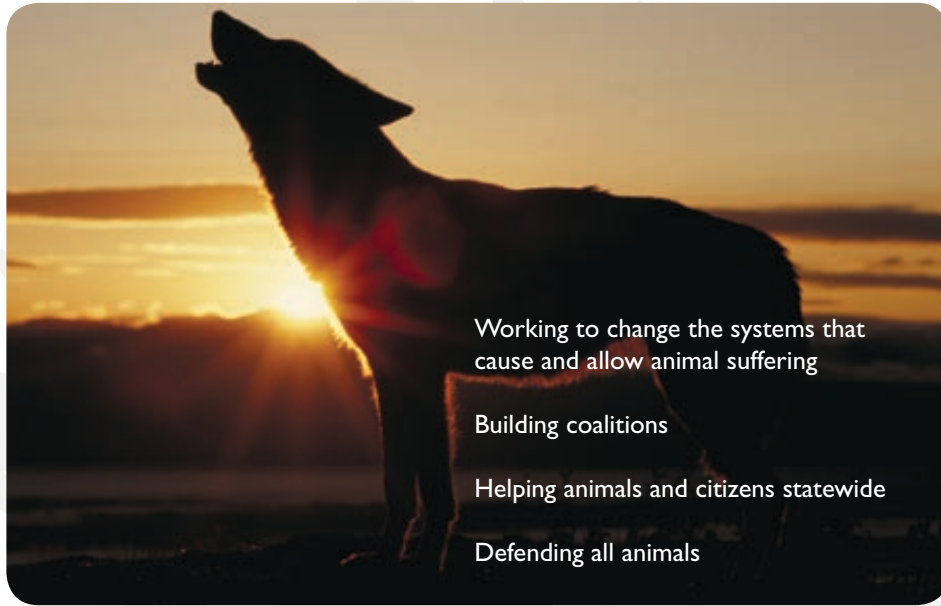
